## Award Guidelines for the Pastors' Peace Scholarship Fund

A yearly \$500.00 scholarship will be awarded to students who have demonstrated a willingness to promote peace in their relationships and through community or faith based service. This award is to be granted to college freshman through post-graduate studies following completion of their first semester per guidelines below.

The application must be made on behalf of the student by their pastor or congregational leader. Applications should be sent to Michael Langford, chair of the scholarship committee, via email at <a href="mailto:pedalpeace@icloud.com">pedalpeace@icloud.com</a>

Yearly applications for scholarship consideration may be submitted on behalf of the student beginning with the freshman year through post-graduate studies. Applications will be considered as received-there is no deadline for applications. Up to four scholarships will be awarded annually.

- 1. The pastor must express to the awards committee, via a letter or essay, the qualities that best demonstrate the student's worthiness for a scholarship.
- 2. A copy of the student's letter of acceptance to an accredited post-high school institution must be submitted as part of the application.
- 3. A list of the student's course selections with special consideration given to courses such as the humanities, conflict resolution, and peace making skills must be submitted as part of the application.
- 4. The student must have successfully completed the first semester and be registered as a student in good standing for the second semester. Proof of second semester registration is required.
