

Award Guidelines Of the Pastors' Peace Scholarship Fund

A yearly \$500.00 scholarship will be awarded to students who have demonstrated a willingness to promote peace in their relationships and through community or faith based service .

1. The application must be made on behalf of the student by his/her pastor or congregational leader.
2. The pastor must express to the awards committee, via a letter or essay, the qualities that best demonstrate the student's worthiness for a scholarship.
3. A copy of the student's letter of acceptance to an accredited post-high school institution must be submitted as part of the application.
4. A list of the student's course selections with special consideration given to courses such as the humanities, conflict resolution, and peace making skills must be submitted as part of the application.
5. The student must have completed the first semester and be registered successfully as a student in good standing for the second semester. Proof of second semester registration is required.
6. Yearly applications for scholarship consideration must be submitted on behalf of the student beginning with the freshman year through post-graduate studies.
